Parents will be at all swim meets with swimmer(s) and be available to volunteer at the meets, this includes prelims, championships and All Stars (if qualified).

Parents and swimmers will not participate in any activity/behavior detrimental to the swim team.

Parents/swimmer(s) will inform the coach of any disability or ailment that may affect them or the safety other team members.

Parents/swimmer(s) will not engage in any unsportsmanlike conduct.

Parents will be a positive role model for their child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for coaches, officials, team members, team parents and other teams at every practice and events.

Parents will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit their swimmer(s).
